# AUCTION OF SERVICES

Auction services of people and businesses – anything from singing lessons to dinner for two.

## **AEROBICS**

Organise a sponsored aerobathon with the help of gyms, leisure centres and sports shops

#### **ABSEIL**

Scale the dizzy heights of a local landmark or office block and your adrenaline pumping with a sponsored abseil.

## AFTERNOON TEA

Put the kettle on and invite your parishioners round for a cuppa and a chat. Ask everyone to make a donation.

## ARTS AND CRAFTS SALE

Make necklaces,
dried flower
arrangements,
stained glass mirrors,
etc, to sell on a stall.
You could also hold
an auction to sell
works by local artists

#### BINGO

Practice your call outs because bingo's making a comeback. Hold a one-off evening or regular morning sessions.

#### **BARBECUE**

Fire up the grill and serve some mouth watering burgers. Add stereo, football and rounders bats and make it a whole day's event

#### **BOOK SALE**

Sell old books, collected from everyone you know. Book dealers may buy leftover stock.

#### **BOAT TRIPS**

Organise a cruise down a nearby river or canal. Include refreshments & entertainment.

#### **BEER FESTIVAL**

Stock up on international beers, food and music. Remember to check licensing laws.





## **CANDLE MAKING**

Make and sell candles at craft fairs or coffee mornings.

# CONTACLESS DEVICES

Turn small change into big donation by leaving a collection contactless device in your foyer or canteen.

#### **CAKE SALE**

Fancy yourself as the next Bake Off Champion? Cake sales are a great way to raise money at church.

#### **CAR WASH**

Wash cars at shopping centre or office car parks

#### **CAROL CONCERT**

Host a festive concert for your community. Earn extra by selling minced pies & mulled wine.

### **COFFEE MORNING**

Anyone for coffee?
Raise money, catch
up with friends,
parishioners and
bring the community
together.

#### **DINNER PARTY**

Hire a popular and spacious restaurant. Entertain ticket holders with music & comedy.

#### **DANCE**

Barn dances, tea dances, disco dances, salsa dances - whatever rocks your boat

## DARTS TOURNAMENT

Challenge all the pub teams in the area to compete for cash prizes, or a barrel of beer.

#### **DISCO NIGHT**

Spin the decks or hire a DJ to stage a themed disco night

#### **DOG SHOW**

Charge proud petowners to show off their pooches. Ask pet shops to sponsor the event.





## ENDURANCE CHALLENGE

Get sponsored to do 1000 squats or hold a plank for as long as you can.

## EATING MARATHON

Get sponsored to eat as many baked beans/grapes/pies etc. as possible.

## EASTER EGG HUNT

Edible hide and seek. Charge entry fee and ask confectioners to provide the eggs.

#### **EYEBOWS**

Get sponsored to shave them off – they grow back eventually!



#### **FANCY DRESS**

Jazz up your event with a fancy dress contest. Charge entrance fee.

#### FETE

Reach the whole community by holding a fete, or team up with organisers of an annual event.

#### **FILM NIGHT**

Recreate an evening of vintage cinema by showing classic films and musicals. Don't forget the popcorn

#### **FUN DAY**

Arrange games, music, competitions and stalls at a nearby hall or sports club.

#### **FACE PAINTING**

Get creative with face paints at fetes, fairs and children's parties





#### **GARDEN PARTY**

Once Summer pay us a visit. Organise a Garden party. Sell tickets or invite guests to make a donation

### **GREETING CARDS**

Make and sell cards for every occasion. Find out about selling Christmas cards for your church.

#### **GAMES NIGHT**

Indulge in your competitive side an break out the board games for a monopolising evening.

#### **GARAGE SALE**

Sell off all your unwanted belongings. Invite parishioner to organise their own stall

### **GUEST SPEAKER**

Invite a guest speaker and sell admission tickets. Boost funds with raffle & refreshments. HEAD SHAVE Sick of bad hair days? Go bald for charity. Ask for donations to shave your hair.

## HOUSEHOLD SALE

Sell off all your unwanted belongings.



#### HOOK-A-DUCK

Fete and fair game. Ask local companies to donate prizes.



#### **INDOOR MARKET**

Rent out stalls to local traders, or take cut of profits.

#### **INFLATABLE**

Put a bounce into your summer fete with an inflatable fly wall, boxing ring or gladiator court

## IT'S A KNOCKOUT

Revive the 80s game show by inviting teams to compete in silly games in silly costumes.

#### IRONING

It might not be the most fun job, but if you offer your services you could bring in lots of donations!



## JEWELLERY MAKING

Buy your own beads and get threading. Sell your products at markets and craft fairs.

#### **JUNK MAIL**

Collect all your junk mail and sell it to a recycling company

#### JAZZ FESTIVAL

Play your own brand of jazz, or stage a show for local musicians. Sell tickets and refreshments



#### **JAILBREAK**

Dump teams in the middle of nowhere. With no money or transport, see who gets back to base first. Charge entrance fees and offer prizes.

#### **KARAOKE**

Arrange your own
Pop Idol contest. All
you need is a
machine, a room and
a well-stocked bar



### **KNITTING**

Get together with friends and have a knit and natter. Help people wrap up warm by selling hats and scarves for a donation

## LEFT-HANDED DAY


Try doing everything with your left hand for the day.

#### LINE DANCING

It's all the rage. Just make sure you have a caller and plenty of drink!

#### **LAWN MOWING**

Is the grass greener on the other side? Or is it just shorter? Convince your friends and neighbours to let you cut their lawns in return for a donation.





## MUSIC CONCERT

Entertain the crowds with your own recital, or hire bands of musicians.

### MINI-OLYMPICS

Invite everyone you know to compete in traditional & silly sports. Charge entry

#### **MARATHONS**

Get sponsored to run a traditional 26-mile race.

## MEDIEVAL EVENING

Themed evening of medieval food, jousting and entertainment.

It's elementary!
Indulge those crime
fantasies and see
who among your
friends is the sharpest
detective.

#### **NATURE TRAIL**

Offer guided walks to natural beauty spots.

## NEW YEAR RESOLUTIONS

Get sponsored to stick to your new year's resolutions.

#### **NIGHT WALK**

Grab a torch and step into the night.
Remember, there's no need to be scared of the dark.

## NEW YEAR'S EVE

Get the corks popping and the streamers streaming. Organise a New Year's Eve party!





#### **OPEN GARDEN**

Open your garden to visitors. Sell tickets, refreshments, plants and vegetables.

#### **OPERA NIGHT**

Stage an opera evening in your area, or arrange a trip to see a big London production.

## OFFICE OLYMPICS

Think you can make it to the podium for waste paper bin basketball? Or go for gold in the egg and spoon race? Whatever you choose, don't throw in the towel.

## OUTWARD BOUND

Go climbing, hiking, camping, etc, in preparation for your trip. Seek sponsorship.

#### **ODD JOBS**

Get people to sponsor you for helping them out with chores like vacuuming, cleaning or walking the dog.

#### **PLANT SALE**

Sell donated plants or rent out pitches to traders.

## POSTAGE STAMPS

Collect and sell foreign and unusual stamps to dealers.

#### PANCAKE RACE

Get flipping on Shrove Tuesday. Charge teams to enter, and spectators to eat

## PRIVATE TUITION

Whether it's French or Flamenco, sell your skills with private lessons.

#### **PLANT A TREE**

Seek sponsors for a "plant a tree" scheme.

#### **PLEDGES**

Gather pledges of support, donations and services. These could be auctioned or raffled off.





## **QUIZ NIGHT**

Whether it's at a local pub or at church, getting quizzical is a great way to draw in donations. Why not theme it to make things more interesting?

#### **RAFFLE**

Ask local firms to donate prizes and sell tickets. Check raffle laws with charity.

#### RECIPE BOOK

Publish favourite recipes from local restaurants and chefs.

#### **REFRESHMENTS**

Sell teas, coffees, sandwiches, biscuits, cakes, etc, at any fundraising event.

#### RECYCLING

Collect paper, aluminium, glass, etc, and sell on to recycling companies.

#### **RAMBLE**

Take to the countryside for a mass walkabout. Throw in a theme (fancy dress, singles, three legged, Easter), and charge for entry and refreshments.





## SANTA'S GROTTO

Pull on your white beard and brush up your ho, ho, ho.

## SCAVENGER HUNT

Variation on the treasure hunt where participants have a list of items to collect.

#### **SWIMATHON**

Get sponsored per length, mile, minute, hour...

#### SKYDIVING

Free fall your way back to earth – for sponsorship.

## SPORTS COMPETITION

Whatever your game, organise a tournament. Sell tickets, and organise stalls, raffles, etc.

### TALENT COMPETITION

Discover Britain's next big thing with your own talent show. Charge entry and offer prizes.

#### **TOY SALE**

In the run up to Christmas, toy sales can be big fundraisers.

#### **TUCK SHOP**

Sell sweets, crisps, cake, drinks, etc, at a children's event.

#### **TOMBOLA**

Pick a raffle ticket out of a barrel and match it with a ticketed prize. Fair & fete favourite.

## TREASURE HUNT

Sniffing out the clues, teams compete against each other to discover the 'hidden treasure'.





## UNWANTED PRESENTS

Arrange a post-Christmas sale of unwanted gifts. Ask traders to donate a cut of their takings.

## UGLY JUMPERS

Ask people to wear their most awful jumper for a donation and give a prize to the worst.

## VALENTINE'S DAY

Fancy yourself as a matchmaker? Hold a charity speed-dating event. You could also bake some love-themed treats to sell.

## VIRTUAL CHALLENGE

Walk, run cycle or swim towards your own target at your own pace.

## VARIETY SHOW

Comedians, magicians, singers, dancers & musicians all under one roof.

#### **VEHICLE RALLY**

Well-organised car and bike shows are great crowd pullers and fantastic fundraisers.





#### **WALKS**

Lead organised walks to historical spots and places of interest. Ghost walks are also popular.

## WATER SPORTS

Let others splash out as you splash in. Teach water sports or get sponsored to take part.

### **WINE & CHEESE**

Feeling classy?
Whether you hold it at home, local bar or church, this is a great event and a treat for the tastebuds.

## **WINE TASTING**

Hold tasting sessions for wine companies. Charge commission on wine sold.

#### WHISKEY RAFFLE

Charge a pound a ticket, and pick a winner for every 25 sold. Check licensing and raffle laws.

## XMAS EVENING

Stock up on crackers, pudding and mince pies. Break with tradition by holding it in July!


## YARD OF ALE

Work up a sweat and invite family, friends or colleagues to join you in getting your groove on.












## MISSION RESOURCES
