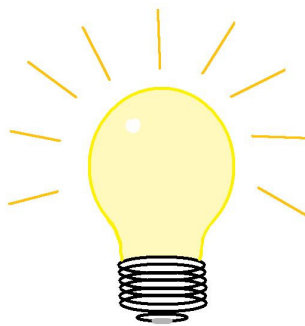

Diocesan Staff

Many dioceses employ advisers who can help parishes, particularly at the early stage of pulling together a funding campaign strategy. Call your Diocesan Office to identify the best individual to talk with and identify any help available.

Diocesan Advisory Committee

The Diocesan Advisory Committee (DAC) will have a range of experts who will be available to offer advice, and it is worth consulting with them sooner rather than later, particularly regarding faculties.
